How it works

Track hours against the project as they happen, at the rate already set.
- 3 Invoice from logged time**
Generate the invoice straight from the timesheet — no manual re-typing of hours worked.
- 4 Bill in the client's currency**
International clients are billed correctly, with the right decimal handling for their currency.
- 5 Send a professional document**
Choose from four print templates, so the invoice looks as considered as the work itself.
