Invoicing software built for how a school actually schedules and bills

A school runs on lesson slots that can't double-book an instructor or studio, and batches that each carry their own price — a beginner class doesn't cost what an advanced one does. Invoice2Track checks every session against the calendar first, and applies the right tier's rate automatically at billing time.

How it works

- 1 Set up batches by tier**
Define Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced, or whatever tiers your school uses — each with its own fee.
- 2 Book the lesson slot**
Reserve an instructor, studio, or class slot, checked against the calendar first — nothing gets double-booked.
- 3 Enroll the student**
Assign a student to their batch once; their fee follows from the tier automatically from then on.
- 4 Let batch fees bill themselves**
A monthly batch fee generates on schedule automatically — no manual re-entry every renewal.
- 5 Track who's current**
See which students are paid up and which fees are outstanding, without a separate spreadsheet.
